Supported Place Application

The National Homelessness Conference 2018 is offering a limited number of supported registrations for people with a lived experience to attend this year's Conference.

The Conference committee is seeking applications from throughout Australia and from across the spectrum of people known to experience homelessness. This includes women who have experienced domestic and family violence, young people, Aboriginal people, older people, people from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds, people from regional and remote locations and people who identify as LGBTQI. We also encourage applications from people who have experienced different forms of homelessness such as rough sleeping and couch surfing.

The applications will be considered by Homelessness Australia to maximise the participation in the conference of those with this range of experiences.

Application notes

- » Supported places include a two-day registration at the conference.
- » This registration does not include assistance with travel or accommodation.
- » This application process is for individuals who have a lived experience of homelessness but do not have the financial means to attend.
- » Applicants can submit their application for a supported place via nomination by a homelessness peak body or through homelessness or other support services.
- » Applications close on Friday June 29, 2018.
- » Applicants will be advised within one week of application date.
