






In the Northern Territory, presentations to homelessness services increase year-on-year.

Young people living in boarding houses




The rate of young people presenting alone to SHS has risen 56% in the last eight years.


Alice Springs Youth Accommodation and Support Services:


- Crisis accommodation = seven beds

#### NHHA Allocations to States and Territories in 2022


















## Do you think young people in Mparntwe are more at risk of homelessness than young people elsewhere?











The Project: What would help?
